We inform you that the *Colloque international Réseaux et solidarités internationales* face à la répression dans les ports et en mer/Troisièmes Journées Jules Durand is to be held at the Université du Havre, 24-25 November 2016.

Jules Durant, a coal porter and leader of the 1910 Le Havre strike, became the victim of a judicial frame-up and the object of a wide-ranging solidarity campaign in his own country and around the world, bringing together human rights activist and trade unionist of all tendencies.

The Conference aims to shed light on the forms of this solidarity with Jules Durand in 1910 and to compare the events of 1910 with other incidents of repression in ports and at sea which also triggered international solidarity, in other places, at other times and on other issues.

MMHN welcomes proposals from scholars working on Mediterranean and Black Sea maritime history since the thirteenth century CE on the use of the sea as a resource, for transport, power projection, scientific purposes, leisure activities, and as an inspiration in culture and ideology.

The papers will be presented at the 5th MMHN Conference to be hosted by the 'Ovidius' University of Constanța in May 2018.
