In 2024 we have welcomed five more members:

- <u>Jeanne Deville, PhD candidate at the University of Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne</u>. Her research focuses on mining history, health in workplace history and social history. Her thesis topic is centered on the social history of health in mining in France and Belgium, from the mid-19th century to the end of the 20th century.
