October 2022 Workshop

Our next workshop will be held on Friday **21 October 2022**. The workshop meets have changed in frequency, and will now be held every four months (three times a year) on Zoom. In these workshops, we discuss new ideas about and core issues on military labour history that we began at the 2021 ELHN/WORCK conference in Vienna. We will also discuss potential topics and formats for the next year's meetings.
