

Hotel information

Amsterdam has a wide variety of accommodation options that fit many budgets and preferences. Closest to IISH we recommend:

Lloyd Hotel <https://www.lloyd.nl/> 1-to-5 star design hotel (room rates: €97 -€ 225 per night) , 10-minute walk from IISH.

Stayokay Amsterdam Zeeburg, Hostel (shared rooms starting at €30 per night), 8-minute walk from IISH.

Amsterdam Tropen Hotel, 3-star eco-conscious hotel (rooms starting at €143 per night), 22-minute walk, 8-minute bike ride or 15 mins by bus from IISH.

Also quite close to the institute is the Hampton by Hilton. We may be able to get a special rate there but the person who I can ask is out of the office until the 6th of November. http://www.hiltonhotels.com/nl_NL/nederland/hampton-by-hilton-amsterdam-centre-east/ (but starts at about 160 Euro).

On IJburg (4 stops with tram and a short walk) is the Amadi Panorama hotels is a good option. <http://panorama.amadihotels.com/nl/index.html>

Other options farther afield: Botel (a hotel on a boat), Citizen M, Cityhub, Casa400, Volkshotel, Volle Maan Houseboat B&B, Arcade Hotel (video game hotel).
