

On Monday, May 15, the "Manfred Grashof Commando" carried out a bomb attack against Judge Buddenberg of the Federal Court of Justice in Karlsruhe. At the Federal Court, Buddenberg is the judge responsible for detention and investigation in all paragraph 129 proceedings.

Buddenberg, the pig, allowed Grashof to be moved from the hospital to a cell when the transfer and the risk of infection in the prison were a threat to his life. The police had already failed to kill the defenseless Grashof, so they tried again to kill him.

Buddenberg, the pig, is responsible for Carmen Roll being put into anesthesia in order to get her to talk. The foreseeable development of the anesthesia has proven that it was an attempt to kill her.

Buddenberg, the pig, doesn't give a shit about existing laws and conventions. The stringent isolation in which prisoners are held to destroy them psychologically: solitary confinement, isolated yard time, the ban on speaking to other prisoners, constant transfers, detention penalties, observation cells, the censoring of mail, confiscation of mail, books and magazines - the measures which are used in an attempt to physically destroy them: the glaring cell lights at night, frequent interruption of sleep for searches, chaining during yard time, physical abuse - are not the actions of insignificant, frustrated prison wardens; these are Buddenberg's orders, meant to force the prisoners to make statements. It is fascism institutionalized in the justice system. It is the beginning of torture.

We demand the immediate application of laws governing remand prisoners, the Geneva Human Rights Convention, the United Nations Charter regarding the enforcement of remand custody for political prisoners. We demand of the justice system that the lives and health of the prisoners no longer be systematically assaulted and destroyed.

We will carry out attacks against judges and state attorneys until they stop committing violations against the rights of political prisoners. We are, in fact, demanding nothing which is impossible for this justice system. We have no other means to compel them to do so.

Freedom for the political prisoners!
Fight class justice!
